



Instructor Lists and Contracts

Only Compressed Air Challenge[®] (CAC) qualified instructors may be hired to teach a CAC training session. Both *Fundamentals* and *Advanced Management of Compressed Air Systems* trainings are designed to be highly interactive learning experiences. Therefore, the use of two instructors is required for all *Fundamentals* training sessions with **more than 30 attendees** and for **all** *Advanced* training sessions. Certain exceptions exist *if* you are co-hosting with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE); please discuss with your DOE contact, if applicable.

A signed [Instructor Agreement](#) is required for each instructor hired to teach either *Fundamentals* or *Advanced Management of Compressed Air Systems* training. The primary host signs the contract with the instructors and makes hotel accommodations for them. The CAC has fixed the instructor's fee at a daily rate of \$1,250 plus expenses for travel, hotel accommodations, and meals. If you like, the CAC can assist you in securing an instructor. All hosts should let the CAC know the instructors' names along with the confirmed date and location for the training.
