2017 MARKETING AND OUTREACH ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Launched new website and logo, <u>www.compressedairchallenge.org</u>
 - Launched new advisory committee structure

2017 TRAINING PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Updated the *Fundamentals of Compressed Air Systems* (L1) training to include SI units for release in 2018
- Updated content of the *Advanced Management of Compressed Air Systems* (L2) training for release in 2018
- Repackaged the L1 and L2 training in a new spiral bound format allowing for more user-friendly international printing in 2018
 - Initiated process to obtain copyrights for CAC training materials
- Worked with the CAC instructor pool to propose a series of updates to the partnership agreements to encourage additional benefits for both the organization and the instructors
- Expanded CAC training services to include turnkey administration CAC management of registration and material orders
